#### CHAPTER 6. NDS - MONITORING AND EVALUATION SYSTEM

#### Tasks of NDS-2030 M&E:

- 1. Demonstrate how far the country has come in achieving its goals.
- 2. To what extent were the results cost-effective
- Identify the strengths (to strengthen) and shortcomings (to eliminate) the results of the implementation of the NDS-2030 and MtDPs.
- 4. Determining the level of participation of all stakeholders in the implementation of NDS-2030.
- 5. Assess the country's development potential after 2030.

#### CHAPTER 6. NDS - MONITORING AND EVALUATION SYSTEM

M&E reports are based on an analysis of the dynamics of the two-level indicator system:

- a) indicators of international level for international comparison; 9 indicators
- of the NDS-2030 components, approved by the state statistical reporting, including the SDG for comparison with the main priorities of the NDS-2030 Blocks and Sections) to identify specific changes, trends and challenges in the process of NDS-2030 implementation, including to identify weaknesses and strengths, opportunities and threats 46.

Monitoring indicators NDS-2030 (once in five years) are based on indicators of the results of the implementation of the Medium-Term Socio-Economic Development Programs of the Republic of Tajikistan (2016-2020, 2021-2025 and 2026-2030).

The bulk of the data, first of all, quantitative data (with gender disaggregation) is provided by the Agency on Statistics under the President of the Republic of Tajikistan (along with specific reporting forms for relevant governmental and non-governmental organizations), including by the ministry and other agencies on the relevant areas of their activities, taking full responsibility for data collection. The use of expert research results also plays an important role.

# THE ROLE OF THE STATISTICAL AGENCY IN PROVIDING INDICATORS FOR THE NDS, MTDP AND SDGS

- The activity of the Agency on Statistics under the President of the Republic of Tajikistan (hereinafter SA) is of special importance in the collection of statistical data for decision-making on socio-economic development, investment climate and timely dissemination of reliable statistical data. Qualitative and timely statistical data prepared by the SA will be used to analyze the socio-economic, demographic, environmental, political and cultural situation in the country, and will help political activists and businesses to make informed decisions. In addition, SA information is used by foreign investors to provide information on investment decisions, as well as by development partners to initiate development initiatives.
- In the process of development, society and the economy face new challenges and place greater demands on government statistics, especially on the composition and quality of official statistics. Therefore, a comprehensive systematic approach should be pursued, which provides for the improvement of the entire statistical production management system, as well as the implementation of measures based on the recommendations of the global assessment of the National Statistical System of the Republic of Tajikistan (NSS) and other advanced development documents were not covered.

# THE ROLE OF THE STATISTICAL AGENCY IN PROVIDING INDICATORS FOR THE NDS, MTDP AND SDGS

- According to the Resolution of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan №585 from November 27, 2019 National Statistics Development Strategy of the Republic of Tajikistan (hereinafter NSDS) for the period up to 2030.
- The NSDS promotes the Government's goal of transforming the state statistics system into a high-level institution that supports policy development based on reliable and quality information, ensuring access to information and expanding the use of administrative data.
- The NSDS has been developed taking into account the National Development Strategy of the Republic of Tajikistan for the period up to 2030, the experience gained from the implementation of previous statistical programs and in accordance with the new approach of the international community to the 2030 Sustainable Development Goals.

### REVIEW OF THE STATUS OF THE STATISTICS AGENCY UNDER THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TAJIKISTAN AND ADMINISTRATIVE SOURCES

Regulatory framework for official statistics

The normative legal basis of the official statistics of Tajikistan is the Law of the Republic of Tajikistan "About the state statistics" from January 12, 2010. This law is in line with relevant international standards, in particular with the basic principles of official statistics and other basic recommendations of international organizations, such as the Code of Ethics for Statistics of International Statistical Institutions (ISI).

### HUMAN RESOURCES OF THE STATISTICAL AGENCY

- There are 1001 employees in the statistical bodies, 499 of them are civil servants: 78 in the Central Office and 421 in the local statistical bodies; 116 employees in the General Computing Center of the SA, 36 maintenance workers, 234 part-time employees of local statistical bodies working on a contract basis.
- Census staff were hired only after interviews and with higher education. The number of temporary staff for the census in the SA is 116 people.
- 98.7% of the staff of the Central Office have higher education, mainly higher economic education, 73.1% and 50% of the staff are women. Employees under the age of 35 make up 45.6%.

### INTERACTION OF STATISTICAL DEPARTMENTS WITH THE MAIN REPORTING BODIES

• In order to reduce the workload of reporting, the transition to electronic reporting in the SA began in 2015, and now 42 forms of statistical reporting are provided through the personal reporting room. This will be followed in NSDS by the complete replacement of paper-based questionnaires with electronic questionnaires (electronic questionnaires structured data collected from primary sources administrative documents), the transition to electronic household books, and finally the creation of a population register.

Government agencies can act as producers of information and conduct monitoring and evaluation of policy in relevant areas. The SA identified the following government agencies as administrative sources with which it works closely.

- The National Bank of Tajikistan (NBT) in accordance with the Law of the Republic of Tajikistan "On the National Bank of Tajikistan" is responsible for the development of banking statistics, monetary and credit, balance of payments, international investment position, gross external debt of the Republic of Tajikistan and analytical situation. Along with its responsibilities, the NBT cooperates with government agencies in the collection and publication of statistics.
- o The Ministry of Finance has the primary responsibility for the development and dissemination of public finance statistics (hereinafter PFS). PFS covers the public administration sector. For the development and dissemination of PFS, Government Resolution No. 588 of 28 December 2006 was approved, which strengthens the normative position of the Ministry of Finance. The information of the Ministry of Finance is developed and disseminated in accordance with the general provisions of the Law of the Republic of Tajikistan "On Public Finance" and the Law on State Budget.

- The Customs Service maintains statistics on foreign trade of the Republic of Tajikistan. Sources of information when compiling foreign trade customs statistics shall be the information contained in the cargo customs declarations and other customs documents. Information is compiled on a monthly basis.
- The Ministry of Health and Social Protection, the Republican Center for Statistics and Medical Information develops medical statistics (indicators of public health) and sectoral statistics (indicators of the Ministry's institutions networks, staff, beds, etc.).
- The Ministry of Education and Science compiles reports on pre-school institutions, primary and secondary vocational and higher education institutions, and general education institutions. The following priorities have been identified timely and regular submission (reporting data should be entered at regular intervals and at short intervals between collection and use).
- o The Ministry of Labor, Migration and Employment collects and processes data on 11 forms of state statistical reporting.

- o Migration Service of the Ministry of Labor, Migration and Employment on the amount and composition of foreign labor force; collects statistical data on the sex and age composition of foreign citizens operating in the territory of the Republic of Tajikistan, the number of foreign citizens by country of birth, internal voluntary migration and environmental migration. Sources of information are the Migration Service, the State Border Protection Service of the State Committee for National Security and the Passport and Registration Service of the Ministry of Internal Affairs.
- The Department of Civil Status Documents of the Ministry of Justice provides information on state registration of births, deaths, and marriages. Information is collected on the basis of medical certificates of birth and registration documents by statistical reporting forms.
- The Committee for Environmental Protection shall assess the main indicators of emissions into the atmosphere, emissions of greenhouse gases, emissions of pollutants into the atmosphere from mobile sources, the number of inspections conducted, the number of detected environmental violations, the amount of fines and penalties.
- The Ministry of Transport receives statistics on the availability and technical condition of motor vehicles (state motor vehicles and private motor vehicles) from the Department of State Automobile Inspectorate of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Tajikistan as of December 31 of each year.

- The State Committee on Land Management and Geodesy collects information on the condition of land, including arable land, which is divided into categories of use and territorial area. This information is provided by the Committee from land management committees of cities and districts of the country. The work consists of collecting cadastral information on land resources of the Republic of Tajikistan.
- The Tax Committee collects information on the execution of the state budget, which is provided by the structural units of the Committee in the regions. The Tax Committee does not have a statistics department. There is a department for accounting of taxpayers, taxes and information technology, which is financed within the approved budget of the Tax Committee.
- The State Committee on Investments and State Property Management is preparing reports on external assistance and grant assistance from development partners. In addition, the Committee collects information on the privatization of state property and submits it to the Agency on Statistics on a quarterly and annual basis for analysis and dissemination.








#### Population (at the end of the year), thousand people




Real GDP growth rate on average per year \*,%




#### GDP per capita, Somoni





### SHARE OF INDUSTRY IN GDP,%




#### Share of agriculture in GDP, %








### ELECTRICITY PRODUCTION BILLION KW / H (INCLUDING AT HYDROELECTRIC POWER STATIONS)




# LIFE EXPECTANCY (INCLUDING MEN AND WOMEN)




#### PASSENGER TRAFFIC IN BILLION PERSON-KILOMETERS


#### FREIGHT TURNOVER IN BILLION TON-KILOMETERS






#### Growth of real wages (average growth per year)




#### Proportion of women's wages to men's wages




#### Coverage of children from 3 to 6 years with preschool education institutions






Total expenditures on science,% of GDP




## INCREASE IN REAL PENSIONS BY % INCREASE IN NOMINAL PENSIONS BY %






