EVALUATION OF IMPLEMENTATION OF PROGRAM MEASURES


Carrying out activities with the aim of determining the results of the analysis of the collected data to reveal:

- the effect of activities related to the implementation of the policy
- the need to introduce adjustments in order to improve the actions of state authorities and other participants in the process.

MAIN TYPES OF EVALUATION

- 
- evaluation of the process shows the effectiveness of the actions of the state government participating in the program, which actions are proposed, which of them have been implemented, and which methods are used.

- 
- evaluation of the results shows the state of the objects of analysis after the implementation of programs or strategies. Evaluation of the process and results also determines the connections between activities and their results. Their goal is to identify deviations from the plan or failures during the implementation of planned actions.

- 
- impact evaluation shows the level of achievement of development goals and tasks after obtaining relevant results.

MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NDS 2030

M&E of implementation of NDS 2030 should be conducted on the basis of regular monitoring of approved indicators

- measurement criteria, consistency, low value of data collection, direct reflection of intermediate results to answer the questions:
- have the planned measures been implemented,
- whether the expected target indicators have been achieved,
- to satisfy the intermediate results of the policy measures, which are foreseen in the action matrix.

M&E of NDS 2030 is implemented under the guidance and in accordance with the authorized body for coordinating the monitoring and evaluation system in the Republic of Tajikistan.

The authorized body conducts monitoring and evaluation together with the relevant sectoral and regional management bodies, civil society organizations and business structures, including involving development partners.

Submits five-year reports on the implementation of the Strategy to the National Development Council under the President of the Republic of Tajikistan.

MAIN POINTS MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NDS 2030

to show the country's progress towards achieving the set goals;

to show the effectiveness of the used resources in achieving the results;

revealing the priorities for strengthening the results of the implementation of the medium-term development program within the Strategy;

to reveal the causes of defects, obstacles, problems and finding ways to eliminate them;

determining the level of participation of all stakeholders in the implementation of the Strategy;

evaluation of the potential for the development of the country after 2030.

REPORT ON MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF THE NDS 2030

The report on the monitoring and evaluation of the National Development Strategy 2030 will be reviewed by the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan within the National Development Council with the participation of development partners and other stakeholders.

Reports on monitoring and evaluation are formed on the basis of the analysis of the dynamics of the system of indicators at two levels:

- international level indicators for international comparisons;
- national indicators, including macroeconomic indicators, indicators of the Strategy, the Program, as well as nationalized indicators of the SDG

The report will be used to:

- revealing changes, trends and special problems during the implementation of the Strategy,
- to identify weaknesses, strengths, opportunities and risks.

REPORTING

National indicators include the following information:

indicators for monitoring the implementation of the measures taken, including impact indicators, based on which qualitative and quantitative evaluation of changes is formed, and it serves as a source of information for decision-making and justification of new priorities.



Indicators for monitoring the Strategy (every five years) are determined based on the indicators of the results of the implementation of the medium-term development programs of Tajikistan and the indicators of the SDG.



The reports of ministries and sectoral offices on monitoring and evaluation are submitted to the Secretariat of the National Development Council according to the uniform forms approved by the Council.
