**3<sup>rd</sup> Dushanbe Water Action Decade Conference,** 10-13 June 2024, Dushanbe Organized by the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan in cooperation with the United Nations, the Conference will provide a platform to promote the outcomes of the 2023 UN Water Conference.

- to support the implementation of the goals and targets of the Water Action Decade;
- to review the progress catalyzed by the UN 2023 Water Conference with a specific focus on implementing the Water Action Agenda and identifying obstacles and opportunities related to fulfilling the commitments outlined in the Water Action Agenda;
- to share best practices and innovative solutions;
- to strengthen partnerships among stakeholders;
- to promote the role of water in sustainable development;
- to raise awareness and mobilize political will to accelerate progress towards achieving the water-related goals of the 2030 Agenda;
- to contribute to the High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development in 2024 and preparatory process of the UN Water Conference in 2026;
- to provide a mechanism to encourage governments, the United Nations and all other partners to translate good intentions into actions on the ground and catalyze new commitments to be registered in the Water Action Agenda.




- *National Preparation Plan* adopted by the Government;
- National Organizing Committee (NOC) established under the chairmanship of the Prime Minister;
- International Advisory Committee consist of 40 Composed of approximately 40 eminent experts;
- *Conference Secretariat* established under MFA;
- Concept Note and Structural Program approved by NOC;
- *Terms of Reference* prepared for organizing interactive dialogues, forums, side events and the exhibition;
- *Invitation Letters* over 400 invitation letters sent;
- Communication strategy developed to raise national and global awareness.







# INTERACTIVE DIALOGUES



### **PREPARATION TOWARDS**

- Five Interactive Dialogues are expected to focus on review of the progress catalyzed by the UN 2023 Water Conference particularly implementation of the Water Action Agenda
- Co-chairs of the respective interactive dialogues of the UN 2023 Water Conference with the support of preferably up to 2-3 partners one from United Nations entities and two from other stakeholders' organizations including financial institutions.
- Co-organizers of the dialogues may wish to designate one of them as the lead for the purpose of coordination of activities with the Conference Secretariat and interaction with the broader Conference process.
- In case if one of the co-chairs of the interactive dialogues of the UN 2023 Water Conference may be unavailable to play the role of the co-chair of the Dushanbe Conference, the second co-chair may invite another UN member state to cochair the correspondent dialogue.

### **INTERACTIVE DIALOGUES**



- Up to 5 key messages and at least 3 or 4 follow-up actions and Water Action Agenda new voluntary commitments from each Interactive Dialogue;
- A summary of the outcomes of the dialogues will be presented at the Closing Session by a rapporteur;
- A document with the full outcomes will be prepared by the coorganizers of the dialogues;
- The outcomes will be compiled in the final report of the Conference;
- > The **final report** will be made available online and circulated widely.


